***The Sovereignty of God  
Romans 9:6-13***

*Takeaway 1: To be a true Jew is a matter of the heart and not of the flesh.*

**2. God's Sovereignty Demonstrated Through \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_**

*Paul recounts the divergent paths taken by Moses and Pharaoh to vindicate the righteous character of God. Their story does this in two ways. First, it demonstrates God's grace in that he intervened in the life of both men, giving both ample opportunity to humble themselves and accept His right of sovereignty. Second, it demonstrates God's justice, in that He responded to each man according to his own choice. The bottom line: God alone deserves credit for salvation; the condemned person is solely culpable for his or her punishment. ~ Chuck Swindoll*

The staff and elders of CBC along with leadership from the Central Florida YMCA have worked together to develop a 3-phase re-opening plan in accordance with Centers for Disease Control requirements to open our doors for in-person worship that will be as safe as possible. We realize that we cannot control every variable so, for those choosing to attend in person, they do so at their own risk.

## PHASE ONE GUIDELINES

### BUILDING ACCESS

- Please allow 6-feet of space between you/your family and other guests to CBC as you enter the YMCA through the main doors. We will have both sets of doors open.
- While we will not be taking anyone's temperature, if anyone has had a fever in the last forty-eight hours, we ask that they stay home that Sunday and watch online.
- We ask that you refrain from handshakes and hugs while in the building. While you may feel comfortable with this expression of love, we realize that others will not.

### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Masks and gloves will be worn by the service team and greeters and when appropriate
- The wearing of masks by congregants is highly recommended from the parking lot to their seat in the gym. Once in the gym, and safe distancing is in place, masks may be removed.

### SEATING

- Each row will be set up with a missing row of seats between them so that there will be twice as much space as before. We ask that families in the same household sit together and allow for 3 seats in between the next person/group.

### DISMISSAL

- Once the service is over, we ask that you maintain social distancing guidelines until you leave the building.

### CHILDCARE

- As always, your children are welcome into our worship service. During Phase One, there will be no childcare available. We ask that children be seated with their families. If a child is being disruptive, please bring your child to the meeting room to watch the service in there.

### ONLINE WORSHIP

- Our services will continue to be broadcast at 10 am through YouTube, Facebook, and our website. If the internet at the Y does not support live streaming, the service will be available as soon as possible after the service ends.

### OTHER CONCERNS

- If you have the slightest concern that you or any members of your family may be experiencing any illness whatsoever, please stay home
- If you have the slightest concern about being immuno-deficient or immune-suppressed, or are at all anxious about the possibility of contracting any communicable disease, please stay home.
- Please limit restroom use to the four family restrooms in the hallway leading to the pool. Please refrain from using the locker room facilities or other restrooms in the building
